EVENT DETAILS



Welcome to Rounds Five and Six of the 2022 ACU Michelin British Enduro Championship, hosted by Witley and District Motor Cycle Club.

We are delighted that you can join us on the golden stubble of Down Farm at Odiham for this festival of enduro. Down Farm is the location of our event village and camping area for the full weekend.

This event is designed to be similar to European Championships or even an ISDE. Commencing on the Friday evening, Championship and Expert riders will be challenged by our 'Witley Rhythm' Prologue including logs, blocks, tyres, skips, cars and other man-made obstacles. With a live band and beer tent, this will be a real spectacle for all to enjoy.

On Saturday and Sunday, our 68 mile lap, 50% of which is off tarmac, will traverse the scenery of North Hampshire from Odiham to Alton, taking in our four fantastic Special Tests. First up is the XC Test at Down Farm to assess riders cross country ability in the start area for easy viewing by spectators, next is the Enduro Test of traditional forestry going to challenge riders technical ability, before the MX Test at Cannons Hill tests riders out and out speed. Finally the Carey MX Test will emulate a format we have seen at the famous Trefle Lozerien Enduro, and will surprise many!

This event is the culmination of months of hard work by volunteers. I would like to thank the whole team for putting this event on, especially Assistant Clerks of the Course Robert Carey and Ian George, Secretary of the Meeting Gordon Kerr, Publicity Officer Laurie Richards and Special Test planners Neil Bowker, Daniel Alldred and Robert Mussell.

We hope you enjoy our three-day Festival of Enduro.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

VENUE

Down Farm, Odiham, Hampshire, RG29 1QX. The venue will be signposted from Junction 5 of the M3. **Strictly no machines or vehicles to be ridden or driven outside of competition at the venue.** This includes pit bikes/ mini bikes/ scooters or quads. No trade stands without prior permission.

PARKING/CAMPING

All attendees must park where directed by officials. Overnight camping is available at the venue from Thursday 8th September until Sunday 11th September. Local hotels can be found in Odiham, Hook and Basingstoke.

INSURANCE

The insurance cover for this event will be BASIC (limit of liability £10 Million) and Medical Malpractice Insurance (limit of liability £5 Million) is included. **Competitors are strongly recommended to purchase their own personal accident cover.**

SIGNING ON

All competitors must **sign on between 1200 and 1600 on Friday 9th September** before presenting their machine to Technical Control. You will be issued pre-printed rider numbers that must be clearly displayed on your machine, unaltered.

MACHINE EXAMINATION

Competitors must present their **machines for examination between 1200 and 1600 on Friday 9th September.** All motorcycles must be fitted with enduro tyres to FIM/ACU specification. Riders must also present their helmet with the correct ACU stamp, and an environmental mat, which must be used when refuelling. **Noise testing may take place and the Clerk of the Course reserves the right to exclude any machine he deems excessively noisy.**

HOLDING AREA

There is **no** Parc Fermé at the event, so riders will be responsible for their own machines overnight. **All riders are to place their machine in the 'Holding Area' prior to 0800 on both Saturday and Sunday.** Championship and Expert riders should note the prologue instructions overleaf.

START

0800 on Saturday 10th September, 0800 on Sunday 11th September. The Start Order shall be Sportsman, Over 50, Over 40, Clubman, Expert and Championship on both days. Championship Class shall start in the reverse order of current BEC standings. Other riders will start in the order determined by the organiser.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS



ROUTE

This will be in excess of 65 miles of public highway, roads, green lanes, tracks and private land. The course will be marked by tape and arrows. The duration of the event may be up to eight hours. Riders declare when they enter the event that they are taxed, licenced and insured to ride the machine in question, and their machine complies with all legal requirements. **The penalty for receipt of any RTA offence while competing in the event is disqualification and reporting to ACU Head Office with a recommendation from the clubs for a further penalty to be applied.**

SPECIAL TESTS

There are four separate Special Tests which will be available for viewing from 1000 Thursday 8th September. When visiting tests, competitors must park responsibly and where directed by officials. **Viewing by bicycle or any wheeled or mechanical/electrical means is prohibited.**

XC Test: Located at Down Farm, Odiham, Hampshire, RG29 1QX

Enduro Test: Located at Inwood Copse, B3046, RG25 2HP (///gender.cemented.photo)

NB: Strictly no spectators or supporters at the Enduro Test during competition.

MX Test: Located at Cannons Hill Raceway, Neatham Mill Lane, GU34 4NS
(///decisions.haunt.uniforms)

Carey Test: Located at Down Farm (same details as XC test). **NB: Any rider failing to complete the full duration of this test will be awarded the slowest time in their substantive class plus 120 seconds.**

REFUELLING

Must only take place in the designated areas on an environmental mat. **Smoking is prohibited and any competitor working on or fuelling a bike not on an environmental mat will be disqualified.**

BLUE TAPE AREAS

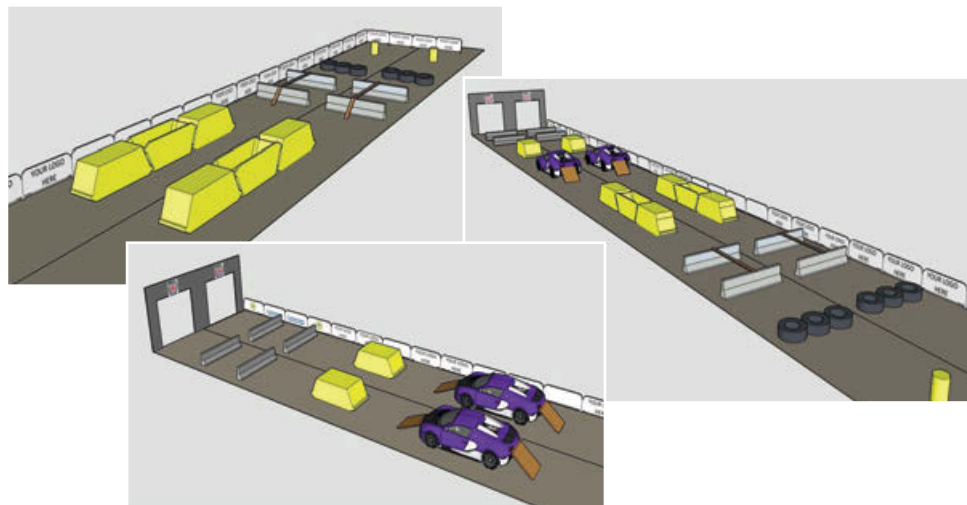
The refuelling point, approach to time controls and track crossings will be designated blue tape/walking pace areas. **The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.**

FIRST AID

Will be provided by Team Medic. Please report any incidents to event officials. The nearest hospitals are Basingstoke and North Hampshire (RG24 9NA) and Frimley Park (GU16 7UJ).

EVENT SECURITY

It is the responsibility of riders to ensure their machine and equipment is kept secure. Neither the Club or ACU accepts any liability in any cases.



For Championship and Expert Riders only, a 'Super Test' – the 'Witley Rhythm' Prologue – will take place on Friday 9th September from 1700-1900. This will take the form of two timed runs on a man-made, two lane obstacle course, similar to the EnduroGP format.

- Riders to meet at the Holding Area from 1645. Timecards will be issued;
- Riders will be given set times for each of their two 'runs'. Riders will complete one run in each lane to ensure the same distance is traversed;
- The start order will be the reverse order of the current BEC overall standings, with any other riders' start times being determined by the organisers;
- Riders will be allowed to collect their machine 10 minutes before each run;
- Riders will be allowed to start and warm their machines two minutes before their first run;
- At the completion of their first run, riders will be allowed back into the Paddock while waiting for their second run;
- At the completion of their second run, riders will be given 15 minutes in the Paddock to carry out any work/ repairs etc. However, no tyre changes are permitted after the Prologue;
- When riders have completed both runs and completed their time in the work area, they must proceed to the time check (no early penalty as per final check of the day);
- The times from the Prologue will be added to the Special Test total for Round 5 (Saturday). Riders who fail to appear for the Prologue will receive a DNF for their Round 5 result;
- Riders failing to finish the Prologue due to injury or mechanical breakdown shall be issued with the slowest rider's time in their substantive class, plus 60 seconds;
- All other penalties such as late/early at time checks or infringements of BEC Championship Regulations, or ACU ESR's shall apply in the usual manner. Riders who arrive late at the start line of the Prologue shall incur a 20 second penalty.

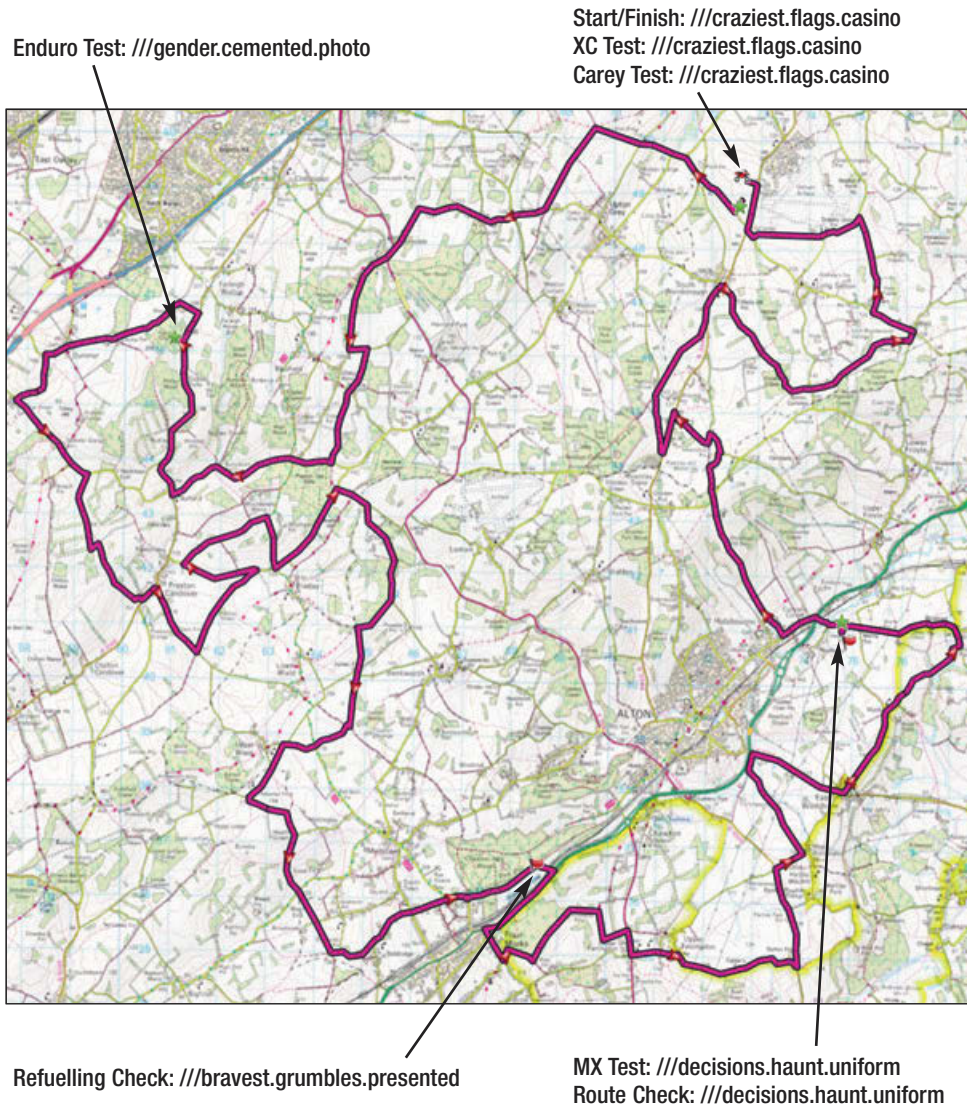
DISQUALIFICATIONS

- Not riding at walking pace in the **BLUE** tape area
- Smoking in the refuelling area (*including E-cigarettes*)
- Refuelling outside designated area or not on environmental mat
- Not keeping to the course / course cutting
- Irregularities in lap times recorded suggesting course cutting
- Failure to keep any support crewmember out of prohibited areas
- **ANY RTA OFFENCE**

SERVICE ROUTE

To avoid potential issues on the public highway, all servicing and spectating crews are asked to follow the below service route.

- **Down Farm, Odiham, Hampshire, RG29 1QX** (///craziest.flags.casino)

Start – TC3 – TC6 – XC Test – Carey Test

Take the one-way system out of Down Farm to the road. Turn left, and then turn right at the crossroads onto the B3349 towards Alton. Follow the B3349 for approximately six miles until you reach the roundabout, and take the second exit (right) onto Basingstoke Road/ B3349.

After half a mile, turn left onto Pertuis Avenue (A339), and continue for one mile, and turn right into Chawton Park Road (before you pass the French Horn Public House). Continue for three quarters of a mile, and turn left into Northfield Lane (just after the Cricket Club).

At the roundabout, take the fourth exit (right) onto the A31. Follow the A31 for a quarter of a mile in the right hand lane, and turn right into Brick Kiln Lane.

CAUTION – COMPETITORS WILL BE APPROACHING.

Park where directed by officials.

15 minutes by road (competitors will take one hour).

- **Four Marks, Hampshire, GU34 5ET** (///bravest.grumbles.presented)

TC1 – TC4 – Refuelling Area

Turn back the way you came, and turn left onto the A31. Proceed along the A31 for four miles, and then take the first exit on the roundabout, signposted to Binsted and Holybourne. Then turn right into London Road.

CAUTION – COMPETITORS WILL BE APPROACHING.

After one mile you will go under the A31, and Service Parking is located on the corner of Lower Neatham Mill Lane in the field marked with arrows.

10 minutes by road (competitors will take 30 minutes).

- **Cannons Hill Raceway, Neatham Mill Lane, GU34 4NS**

TC2 – TC5 – MX Test

SERVICE ROUTE



Coming out of Lower Neatham Mill Lane, turn left onto London Road.

CAUTION – COMPETITORS.

Follow the road for one mile, and then bear right onto London Road towards Alton Town Centre. After half a mile, turn right at the roundabout onto Church Street and Old Odiham Road before taking the third exit on the left into Greenfields Avenue.

At the end of the road, turn right at the roundabout onto the B3349 and follow the road for six and a half miles to Down Farm.

20 minutes by road (competitors will take 35 minutes)

- **Down Farm, Odiham, Hampshire, RG29 1QX** (///craziest.flags.casino)

Start / Finish – Bowker XC Test – Carey MX Test

NB: STRICTLY NO SPECTATING AT THE ALLDRED ENDURO TEST DURING COMPETITION

NB: Riders and support crews are reminded that refuelling is only permitted at Down Farm in the work area, and at Four Marks in the refuelling area. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.

NB: Caution should be taken at all times on the Service Route. All areas are public highway and particular attention should be given to any competitors travelling along the course.

REFUELLING CHECK

For competitors whose machines are unable to complete the full lap (c.68 miles plus Special Tests), there is a Refuelling Area halfway around the course at Four Marks (directions as above).

You can leave fuel in this area on Friday 9th ready for the weekend, or share a service crew with fellow competitors.

XC Test

King John's Castle

King John began construction of a castle on the banks of the River Whitewater in 1208. It provided a convenient stopping place, halfway between Windsor and Winchester (then the Capital of England), where he could also indulge his passion for hunting at Odiham's Royal Deer Park. It is believed that King John rode from his castle at Odiham in 1215 to sign the Magna Carta at Runnymede, after agreeing terms with the feudal barons and forming a cornerstone of the British Constitution as it is today. The remains of King John's Castle can be found at North Warnborough, RG29 1HG.



Basingstoke Canal



The Basingstoke Canal is recognised as one of the most picturesque in the country. It runs through Odiham and North Warnborough and the tow path provides a gentle walking route in the local area. For those wanting a more active visit, Colt Hill Wharf is a centre for boating activity and you can hire canal boats, rowing boats and canoes. The most local car park is off Colt Hill, Odiham, RG29 1FR and by

walking West, you will eventually come to St John's Castle.

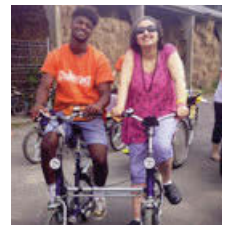
Why Challengers is important

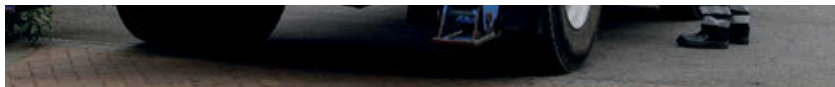

WHERE IT ALL BEGAN

Way back in 1921 a small band of motorcycle enthusiasts used to gather in the yard of Mullards the Builders in Witley. Without doubt, the friendship, the conversation and banter would have been much the same as when motorcyclists get together today.

Numbers slowly increased and a club was formed. By now, many wanted to take part in the Trials and Hill Climbs which were becoming very popular at the time, so the decision was made in 1924 to affiliate to the Auto Cycle Union, and be officially recognised as a Motorcycle Club.

As the number of clubs affiliated to the ACU grew, it was decided to break them down into regions, each region forming itself into a 'Centre'. The region consisting of Kent, Surrey and Sussex, together with the southern half of London, became the South East Centre and has remained so until this day. It was in 1926 that the Witley Club became affiliated to the ACU South East Centre.

Witley MCC has always played a major role, not only in our contribution to the management of the Centre, especially in the early days, but also in the quality of the events we have run and the competitors we have produced.

If you would like to join us, we meet at the Compton Club, Spiceall, Compton, near Guildford, Surrey GU3 1EQ (on the B3000 Godalming road, just off the A3) every Thursday evening from 8.00 pm.

At present our members organise and take part in all types of Trials, Enduros, road runs and social events.
