ELIGIBILITY

All riders must be members of a National Club and hold a current ACU/ SACU Licence and be of a minimum age of 16 years. Any rider from another FMN (including Ireland) must produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident insurance including repatriation. One-day licences will be charged automatically on entry at a cost of £15 to any individual not holding a 2019 ACU Licence.

INSURANCE

The insurance cover for this event will be PREMIER (limit of liability £40 Million) and Medical Malpractice Insurance (limit of liability £5 Million) is included. Competitors are strongly recommended to purchase their own personal accident cover.

VENUE

Down Farm, Odiham, Hampshire, RG29 1QX. Please note that there is strictly no overnight camping at the venue but there are plenty of local hotels. Our thanks to Forestry Commission England for the use of the venue.

START TIME

09:00 hrs. There is no Parc Ferme at the event and competitors will be allowed to return to their vehicles between heats.

ENTRIES (Max. 150)

Entries will through the ACU online entry system ONLY at a cost of £50. Entry fees less an administration charge will only be refunded in the event of cancellation of the event or on receipt of a Doctor's certificate confirming incapacity. **No day entries will be accepted.**

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Final instructions will be published on the Witley MCC website and Facebook page.

COURSE AND FORMAT

This will be around three miles of stubble field, marked with straw bales and tape. Riders will compete in sessions and the format for the day will be as follows: **(NB see separate schedule for times)**

- 0900 Group B (Clubman and Sportsman)
- 0945 Group A (Expert and Veteran)
- 1030 Group B (Clubman and Sportsman)
- 1115 Group A (Expert and Veteran)
- 1200 Group B (Clubman and Sportsman)
- 1245 Group A (Expert and Veteran)
- 1330 Group B (Clubman and Sportsman)
- 1415 Group A (Expert and Veteran)

Viewing the course beforehand is allowed on foot only. Viewing by any bicycle or mechanical/ electrical means is prohibited. Riders are reminded that blue tape areas including the whole paddock are strictly walking pace and any deviation from the marked course will result in exclusion.

TIMING

Timing will be electronic via AMB Transponder. You will be provided a transponder at signing on in return for your ACU licence or £20 deposit. If the transponder is not returned at the end of the event, you will be invoiced for the full cost by ACU Events LTD. Results will be displayed LIVE in the ACU Events vehicle. Results will be given per session, within class with points awarded as follows 25 – 1st, 22 – 2nd, 20 – 3rd, 18 – 4th, 16 – 5th, then decreasing by 1 point to 20th place.

SIGNING ON

Competitors must sign on between 0700 and 0900 hrs before presenting their bike to technical control. You will be issued pre printed rider numbers that must be clearly displayed on your machine, unaltered.

MACHINE EXAMINATION

Competitors should present their machines for examination between 0700 – 0900. All tyres are free choice. Riders must also present their helmet with the correct ACU stamp, a fire extinguisher (min 2kg dry powder type) and an **environmental mat**, which must be used when refuelling. Noise testing may take place and the Clerk of the Course reserves the right to exclude any machine he deems excessively noisy.

MEDICATION

You may be asked to take part in a drugs test. It is your responsibility to declare at signing on if you are taking any drugs.

SECURITY

Competitors must be aware that the security of their machines and other property remains their responsibility at all times.

AWARDS

Will be provided at the end of the day, with a podium presentation.

CHILD PROTECTION

The Secretary of the Meeting is the contact for all Child Protection matters.

GENERAL

The paddock, start area and car park will be marked with blue tape (walking pace). Riders must adhere to walking pace and failure to comply with instructions at such points will incur immediate disqualification.
