AGM Rules:

- Each Full member shall have one vote
- All votes are determined by Majority
 - In the event of a tied vote the Chairman may exercise his right to a casting vote.
- The minutes Secretary shall keep the minutes of the meeting
- This formal notice for the AGM shall be issued a minimum of 21 days before the meeting
- A Quorum for the meeting shall be 20 members with voting rights
- All nominations of candidates for the election shall:
 - Have the consent of the nominee, be in writing (e-mail is acceptable), be seconded, and be received by the Club not less than 14 Days before the AGM. (8th April)
- Any other business must be submitted to the Club not less than 7 days prior to the AGM (15th April) Though the Chairman has the power to accept (or reject) at the meeting items of AoB not notified in advance.
