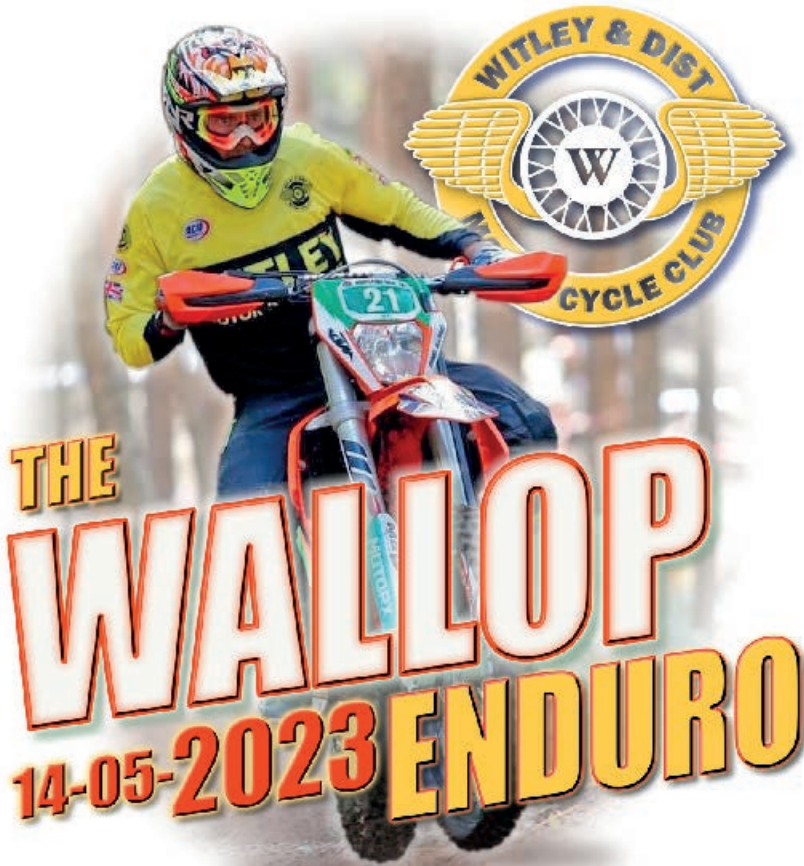

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

VENUE

Farleigh Wallop, Hampshire, RG25 2HP. The venue will be signposted on the B3046 from the crossroads with Garlic Lane/The Avenue. **Strictly no machines or vehicles to be ridden or driven outside of competition at the venue.** This includes pit bikes/ mini bikes/ scooters or quads. No trade stands without prior permission.

PARKING/ACCOMMODATION

All attendees must park where directed by officials. **There is no overnight camping available.** Local hotels can be found in Basingstoke.

INSURANCE

The insurance cover for this event will be BASIC (limit of liability £10 Million) and Medical Malpractice Insurance (limit of liability £5 Million) is included. **Competitors are strongly recommended to purchase their own personal accident cover.**

SIGNING ON

All competitors must sign on **between 0800 and 0930** before presenting their machine to Technical Control. You will be issued pre-printed rider numbers that must be clearly displayed on your machine, unaltered.

MACHINE EXAMINATION

Competitors must present their machines for examination **between 0800 and 0930**. All motorcycles must be fitted with enduro tyres to FIM/ACU specification. Riders must also present their helmet with the correct ACU stamp, and an environmental mat, which must be used when refuelling. **Noise testing may take place and the Clerk of the Course reserves the right to exclude any machine he deems excessively noisy.**

HOLDING AREA

There is no Parc Fermé at the event, and riders should place their machines in start order following technical control, following the instructions of officials.

START

1000 on Sunday 14th May. Riders will start in number order, departing four riders per minute. Please refer to the riders' list for your individual start time.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS



ROUTE

The route is approximately 16 miles of varied forestry going. This includes mixed woodland, natural valleys, disused pits, flinty climbs, hills and brash areas. Riders should be mindful of the nature of endurance competition and take care on the first lap especially.

SPECIAL TESTS

There are two separate special tests which will be ridden untimed on the first lap. Spectators must only spectate from approved areas and be mindful of the dangers presented by motorsport.

REFUELLING

Must only take place in the designated areas on an environmental mat. **Smoking is prohibited and any competitor working on or fuelling a bike not on an environmental mat will be disqualified.**

BLUE TAPE AREAS

The refuelling point, approach to time controls and track crossings will be designated blue tape/walking pace areas. **The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification.**

FIRST AID

Will be provided by Team Medic. Please report any incidents to event officials. The nearest hospitals are Basingstoke and North Hampshire (RG24 9NA) and Frimley Park (GU16 7UJ).

EVENT SECURITY

It is the responsibility of riders to ensure their machine and equipment is kept secure. Neither the Club or ACU accepts any liability in any cases.

ROUTE MARKING



Directional arrow – follow the route ahead



Gated arrows – pass between the arrows



Single turn arrow – turning in 50m



Crossed arrows – danger/hazard



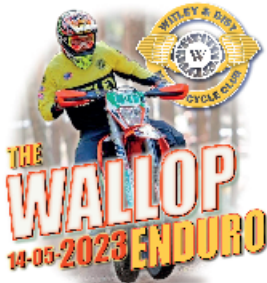
Twin turn arrow – turn immediately



Tape – pass through the taped section

DISQUALIFICATIONS

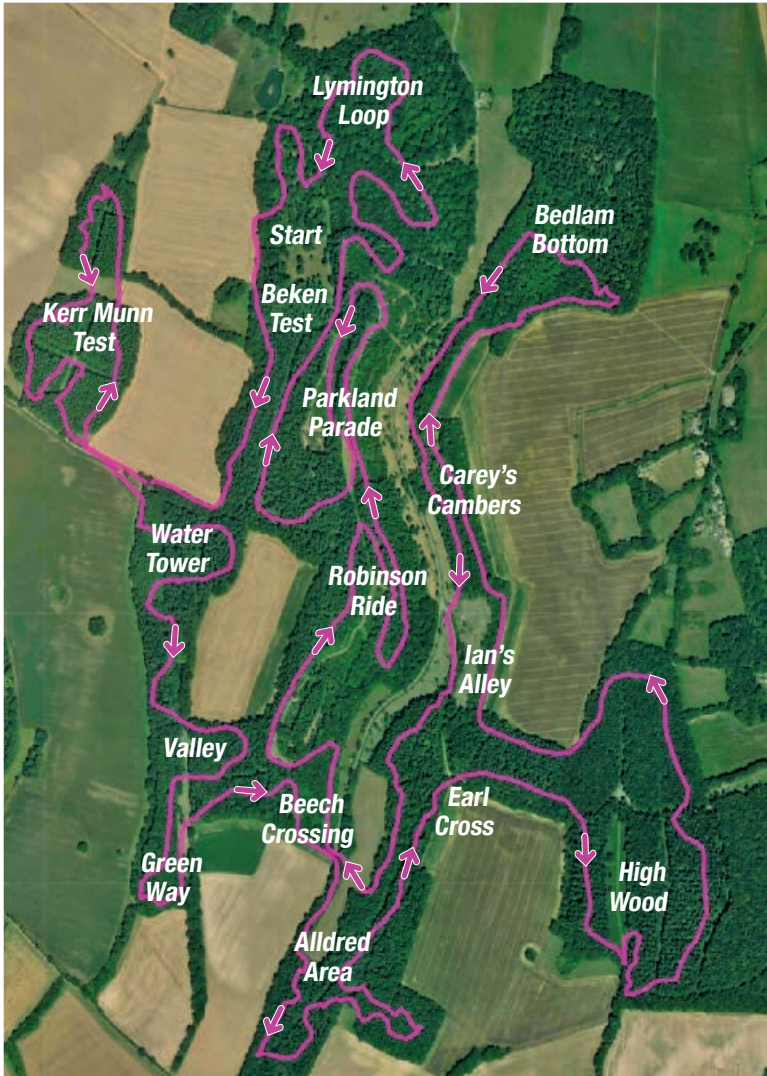
- Not riding at walking pace in the **BLUE** tape area
- Smoking in the refuelling area (*including E-cigarettes*)
- Refuelling outside designated area or not on environmental mat
- Not keeping to the course / course cutting
- Irregularities in lap times recorded suggesting course cutting
- Failure to keep any support crewmember out of prohibited areas

SPECIAL TESTS

KERR MUNN TEST

The brainchild of ISDE Medallist, Ex British Clubman 250 Champion and SEEC Expert Champion Ross Kerr, and Expert rider Reece Munn, this brand new test in virgin woodland will be sure to test riders' technical ability.

Utilising bomb holes and disused pits, together with logging tracks in conifer woodland, Ross and Reece will be looking to bring riders a test which is fast and flowing, while challenging riders with this natural terrain.



BEKEN TEST

Created by father and son team, Simon and Elliot Beken, this test will be located adjacent to the start area for easy viewing by spectators.



With Simon's recent achievement as a Silver medallist at the 2022 ISDE in France, and Elliot's experience at SEEC events, this test will be enjoyable for all levels of rider.

Hosted in an area of newly thinned woodland, the course will snake around larger obstacles for less experienced riders, while seasoned experts can take their chances with an opportunity to gain time on harder routes.

WHERE IT ALL BEGAN

Way back in 1921 a small band of motorcycle enthusiasts used to gather in the yard of Mullards the Builders in Witley. Without doubt, the friendship, the conversation and banter would have been much the same as when motorcyclists get together today.

Numbers slowly increased and a club was formed. By now, many wanted to take part in the Trials and Hill Climbs which were becoming very popular at the time, so the decision was made in 1924 to affiliate to the Auto Cycle Union, and be officially recognised as a Motorcycle Club.

As the number of clubs affiliated to the ACU grew, it was decided to break them down into regions, each region forming itself into a 'Centre'. The region consisting of Kent, Surrey and Sussex, together with the southern half of London, became the South East Centre and has remained so until this day. It was in 1926 that the Witley Club became affiliated to the ACU South East Centre.

Witley MCC has always played a major role, not only in our contribution to the management of the Centre, especially in the early days, but also in the quality of the events we have run and the competitors we have produced.

If you would like to join us, we meet at the Compton Club, Spiceall, Compton, near Guildford, Surrey GU3 1EQ (on the B3000 Godalming road, just off the A3) every Thursday evening from 8.00 pm.

At present our members organise and take part in all types of Trials, Enduros, road runs and social events.
